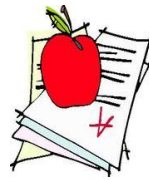


Dress Down Day

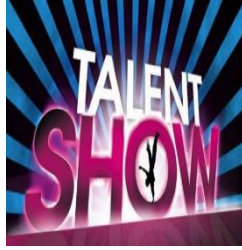
Terry Fox Lightning Ice hockey TEAMS
