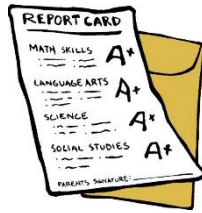
organizing the Halloween Dance that was held on October 26th. The students had a wonderful evening and a total of close to **\$400.00** was raised to give to LEUCAN.

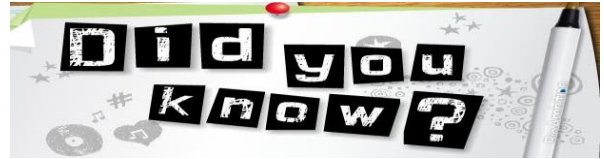
KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION SESSION
