DAYCARE

The Terry Fox daycare is open! If you are interested in registering your child for daycare services after school, please contact **Natasha Turgeon De Bonis** at the school. Daycare fees are \$8.50/day and contribute to a reduction in lunch-hour supervision fees for students who attend on a regular basis (3-4-5 days/week). **Please register before September 24th**.

MORNING ARRIVAL

Parents can park their vehicle in the Community Center parking lot to drop-off their child. However, they should get back to their car as quickly as possible to allow other parents to park their car as well.



Please remember to cross the street at the CROSSWALK where a cross-guard will ensure the safety of your child.

Parking on the bike pathway on des Lacasse could result in getting a ticket from the local police.

What could you do to avoid being caught on **des Lacasse street?**

- Use the back entrance in the school yard (by de Cortina street)
- Use Community Center parking lot
- Leave the house earlier to avoid traffic at school between 7:45 and 8:00am
- Is my child registered to use the bus? If, so I should put him/her on it.

DRESS CODE
